

OOLONG - Chinese

China's oolongs, like its other tea types, span a marvelous range of flavors, appearances, and processing methods. China's oolongs offer something for all types of tea drinkers. Despite their diversity, our premium grade Chinese oolongs share some important characteristics - they are grown in ideal high-mountain regions that have produced top-quality oolongs for hundreds of years and their flavors offer complexity that shifts and deepens with each successive steeping.



BIG RED ROBE (Da Hong Pao)

This is the most famous Wuyi Rock oolong, grown in the "inner mountain" area of Wuyi: medium roast, caramelized sweetness without obscuring the floral aspects or the tea's acidity and characteristic high notes.

DRUNKEN GODDESS

The flavor of this Tieguanyin is slightly subtler than its Monkey Picked counterpart. The flavor is lighter, sweeter and longer lasting.

OLD BUSH NARCISSUS [Lao Cong Shui Xian]

One of the four famous teas of Wuyi Mountain, Old Bush Narcissus falls in between our sold out Iron Monk and Golden Turtle in flavor and strength. Honey sweetness with a balanced roast flavor. This tea is made from tea bushes that are over 100 years old.

JADE (Huang Jin Gui)

Jade oolong is a classical Chinese cultivar and a familiar tea to oolong lovers. This Jade oolong was grown and cultivated in the pristine and ideal conditions of Taiwan. Smooth and bright in flavor and soothing in fragrance.

PHOENIX DAN CONG

From the ChaoZhou area of Guangdong China, this tea grows on tall tea trees and is hand harvested on ladders and then processed by hand as well. This tea opens with great fruity notes of peach and longan fruit, then ends with a distinctive finish of hops. Great choice for Gongfu pots/cup preparation.

MONKEY PICKED TIEGUANYIN
